



## GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS TO OPERATE A FOOD STALL

It is anticipated that approximately 4000 people will attend the Start/Finish Line on each of the three days (Sat, Sun & Mon) and approximately 4000 attend the Scrutineering at Blatherskite Park (Friday night). The hours of operation for the food stalls will commence at 5.00pm at the Scrutineering on Friday 8 June and 8.00am Saturday 9 June, 6.00am Sunday 10 June and Monday 11 June at the Start/Finish Line.

The decision to appoint food stall operators at these functions will be based on product supplied and value for money for our spectators. A proven ability to meet the requirements of catering for these numbers of people is a necessary part of the application form and will also be taken into consideration

The following conditions shall apply:

- Operators will be allocated a specific site and **MUST** operate from this position only. This issue will be discussed with the successful applicants.
- Operators must have relevant public liability insurance and should include documentation of such with their submission.
- Operators must possess the relevant permit to operate a food stall. It is the responsibility of operators to obtain the necessary permit/s and have them displayed.
- You must only provide products for which you have been appointed.
- The expected numbers of people attending these events means we need to be satisfied beyond doubt you will be able to cope with the demand. Considerations include relevant past experience, speed and quality of service provided, adequate staff resources and the capacity to stock adequate supplies of product to meet the demand.
- The organisers of the Finke Desert Race are seeking site fee to cover electricity and waste disposal costs. This fee is **\$120.00 per site, per day** and is payable to Finke Desert Race Incorporated **Thursday 24 May 2012**. Site size has a 4 metre frontage. Should more than one site be required, please advise on the application form.
- Shade may be provided for your outlet at the Start/Finish Line only. Equipment, tables, staff, etc is the appointed operator's responsibility.
- To ensure that your power needs are adequately catered for you will need to advise what equipment will be used in your outlet. Anything additional to what you formally advise will not be permitted, as there could be consequences for the overall power sourcing for the event. All power equipment must be tested and tagged – our safety officer will be checking all power equipment to ensure it complies.
- Applicants should note that observance of Finke Desert Race Incorporated commitment to exclusivity for sponsor's product would need to be considered in your plans.
- Alice Springs Town Council health and safety by-laws will be enforced.
- Please advise if you will be supplying security for your outlet.
