

## AUSTRALIA'S ULTIMATE DESERT RACE JUNE 8-11-2018

## SHANNON AND IAN RENTSCH ON TRACK TO DEFEND FINKE TITLE

Reigning Kings of the Desert, **Shannon and Ian Rentsch** (#33 - Jimco Aussie Special Nissan 3500cc), have maintained top spot as the lead car into Finke for the overnight stop of Australia's toughest off-road race, the Tatts Finke Desert Race.

The father-son duo, hailing from Warrnambool, Victoria, set an impressive subtwo hour time in warm conditions this morning, making the trek in 1 hour 47 minutes and 57.7 seconds.

Minutes later, 2016 Dakar champion and Finke Iron Man hopeful **Toby Price** (#487 2017 Geiser built 6L V8 Chev 360cc) crossed the line in second place nursing a beaten truck with a loose passenger side door.

Price, alongside navigator **Jason Duncan**, prologued fourth on Saturday and finished day one with a gap of 2 minutes 59.3 seconds to the leaders upon arrival at Finke.

2011 Tatts Finke Desert Race winner **Greg Gartner**, alongside **Jamie Jennings** and Mark Hannaford (#410 Geiser Bros Ford Raptor TT Ford 6000cc), rounded out the top three to arrive at the final checkpoint today.

Just seconds behind Gartner was five-time winner **David Fellows with Gregory Rhodes and Mark Bergamin** (#492 Geiser Bros Trophy Truck Nissan 3500cc) in fourth after moving through the field from a Prologue position of 17th.

Queensland's **Talbot Cox and Andrew North** (#16 Racer Engineering Carbon Series Toyota 5600cc) came in to Finke in fifth position, followed by **Michael Marson and Chris Colbourne** (#32 Racer Engineering Carbon Series Ford Windsor 6000cc) in sixth.

After rolling their (#91 - Jimco Aussie Special Nissan) in Prologue, **Jack Rhodes and David Pullino** crossed the line at Finke in seventh position. Rhodes and Pullino will be hoping to move through the field tomorrow to better their third place finish in 2017.

**Ryan Taylor, Nev Taylor and Wayne Bell** (#24 Tatum AK47 Chev 6000cc) finished in eighth position with **Shawn and Robert Swaffield** (#110 Alumicraft Australian VQ35 3500cc) coming in ninth.

Off road legend **Mark Burrows** and navigator **Colin Hodge** (#21 - Jimco MBR Holden 3500cc) rounded out the top ten for day one with a time of 2 hours, 10 minutes and 40 seconds.

West Australia's **Beau Robinson and Shane Hutt** (#413 - Geiser Bros TT Chev 6000cc), who started second off the line this morning, failed to make it to Finke today with mechanical issues.

Three-time bike winner **Phil Lovett** and the competition's first all-electric car, the Acciona 100% Ecopower, steered by **Andrea Peterhansel and Emma Clair**, also failed to finish today's 226km journey.
