15.7 YB Trackers

The first place vehicle and all vehicles within 20 minutes of the leader on Race Day 1 will be required to carry YB Trackers for the return from Finke on Race Day 2. This is a trial run of GPS devices which will not be used to score the placing of vehicles or to assist in any protests or penalties. They are for spectator interest and a test of the technology for possible use in future events.
