

# INFORMATION FOR BIKE COMPETITORS

# The following Finke Desert Race competitor information provides a guide to riders and crews to help keep our event safe.

#### **COVID-Safe Behaviours**

- How to identify symptoms
  - A recent acute respiratory infection (cough, sore throat, shortness of breath)
  - A fever of 37.5C or history of fever (night sweats, chills)
  - Loss of smell or taste
- Stay at home if you're feeling unwell
- Practice hand hygiene by washing your hands or using hand sanitiser
  - Frequently washing hands with soap and water
  - eg. after going to the bathroom, after handling money, before & after eating and touching face or hair
  - Avoid touching eyes, mouth and nose
- Practice physical distancing by keeping 1.5m from those not known to you
- Adopt cashless payment methods
- Download the Covid Safe App to assist with contact tracing
- Check in using the Territory Check In App at all venues
  - Street Party and Night Markets
  - Start / Finish Line Complex in Alice Springs
  - Presentation Night at Alice Springs Convention Centre
- No sharing of bike equipment, tools or apparel
- If more than one person handles equipment, ensure to wipe down surfaces
- Sharing of riding gear such as helmets, gloves and goggles is prohibited

### **Registration Process**

- Update all details in your online entry including up to two crew members. All details of crew members must be completed prior to attending registration.
- Crew to complete the online 'Registration and COVID-19 declaration' and pay cost of \$20 per crew member.
- Bike Competitors will receive the Motorcycle Australia declaration form via email to complete and return prior to registration.
- Once at registration, the registration official will check all has been completed.
- A reminder the competitor must bring proof of MA licence and Ambulance Cover.
- Only the competitor is permitted into the building to complete registration and collect their pack. If under 18, competitor is permitted to be accompanied by parent or guardian.



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#### **Scrutineering Process**

- A hard copy self-scrutineering form will be provided in your competitor pack.
- You will need to complete your self-scrutineering form prior to scrutineering on Friday night.
- Upon arrival at scrutineering, provide your self-scrutineering form to officials.
- Park your competition bike in the designated areas as instructed by officials.
- Race officials will be randomly selecting competitors for an in person audit of your self-scrutineering.
- Competitors who are selected for audit will be notified when handing in your self-scrutineering form.

### **Drug Testing**

• Random drug testing will be conducted by Motorcycling Australia officials throughout the race weekend.

Under NO circumstances should ANYONE with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the event. In the event you develop symptoms over the race weekend please present to the COVID Marshall.
